### Insurance

We are a participating provider for many dental PPO and HMO insurance plans. We ask that you provide us with your dental insurance information at the time of scheduling your appointment so that we can verify benefits and confirm coverage. In most cases, insurance does not cover the full cost of surgical care. It is designed to reduce your cost, but not to eliminate it completely. Your portion of the cost (deductible, co-payment, and other non-covered charges) will be collected before service is rendered. Our staff will file an insurance claim and will assist you in obtaining the maximum benefits available under your policy. However, please remember you are ultimately fully responsible for all fees charged by this office regardless of insurance coverage.
